How is this referendum different from last year?

We listened and we heard you.

Based on more than six months of community feedback, Lewiston-Altura Public Schools is right-sizing its budget, actively engaging with the community, and communicating regularly. This District is also returning to voters on Nov. 5 with a proposal that is \$19 million less than last year.

The school board voted unanimously to propose a two-question referendum:

Question 1 is a Levy for Learning to increase dollars for curriculum and instruction, programs, and activities to support academic success for all learners.

Question 2 is a Bond for Basics for \$19.95 million to fund updates to classrooms and science labs; create student flex space; update mechanical and electrical systems; and fund safety and security improvements.
