Why does the school district need more operating funds?

1. To address the budget deficit caused by rising costs, declining enrollment, and state funding that has not kept pace with inflation.
2. To pay for curriculum and instruction, programs, and activities to support student success.

The school district is seeking voter approval for an operating levy renewal and increase on Nov. 5.

- **Current Levy: \$52 per pupil unit, set to expire next fiscal year.**
- **Proposed Levy: \$760 per pupil unit.**
- **State Average of Rural Minnesota districts: \$850 per pupil unit.**

This levy is crucial to maintaining and improving district operations.
